### Toyota is No Longer the Global Benchmark

**Presented by Gary Stewart**

Gary will use the Toyota example to examine the role executive leadership has on the issue of long term sustainability, and therefore viability, in the global context.

He will contend that while many of us are busy applying Lean to our manufacturing processes, we are working with unsustainable business models, and on unsustainable products because most firms today are still using old leadership models focused on design for manufacture and assembly, instead of new Leadership models focusing the entire business on design for whole of product life which drives better quality, cost and business sustainability outcomes.
